The miracle is a parable: spiritual blindness occurs when we misunderstand the Christ.

- Disciples: doubt, confusion, "spiritual depression."

The need for honesty:

- Don't declare prematurely that your blindness is cured.
- Don't despair that your vision is still blurry.

The need for community:

- Without community we will never see clearly.



The need for Christ:

- He is ultimate reality.

The Question: "Who do you say that I am?"



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The Answer: The Christ (Messiah, Anointed One).

Big Idea: Jesus is the Christ, but what does that mean?

Peter's Understanding (8:29). - He's the King (the Messiah).



Peter's Understanding (8:29). - He's the King. Peter's Misunderstanding (8:31-33). - But not the suffering king.

Isaiah 53:10 Yet it was the will of the Lord to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the Lord shall prosper in his hand.

Jesus is the Suffering King.

The cross is the throne that brings his Kingdom to earth.



The Silence? - They don't understand his

mission. - Do you?



Mark 8:31. And he began to teach them

that the Son of Man **must** suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and be killed, and after three days rise again.

1. The cosmic necessity-The universe is broken. God will redeem creation.



2. The legal necessity-Someone has to pay the penalty for sin. God chose to pay this himself.

3. The personal necessity-God loves us and wants to live with us. His love demands his death.

The indwelling Christ-Galatians 2:20. I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
