OBSERVATION -- As a group, talk through and summarize the passage. Think through *Who*, *What*, *Where*, *When*, *How*, *Why* questions together.

INTERPRETATION -- Answer these questions together:

1) What does this passage teach us about us (mankind)?

a) God uses the trials of life to reveal the idols of our heart. How has this current trial revealed an idol in your heart?

b) Is there someone in your life that you could show mercy to by allowing them to change gradually in "baby steps?"

c) Have you ever experienced a changed heart as you showed mercy to someone else?

2) What does this passage teach us about God?

a) How does God use Joseph to reveal his mercy in this story? How might God use you to reveal his mercy this week?

b) Read Exodus 34:6-7. What do we learn about God's mercy from this passage? How does the mercy of God bring you comfort today?

3) What does this passage teach us about grace/salvation? How does it point to Christ? a) Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Why do we all need mercy from God? How does God's mercy save us?

APPLICATION

a) Is there a broken relationship in your life that needs to be restored? Is there something in your heart that needs to change before reconciliation can occur?

PRAYER

Praise God for his mercy (pray Ephesians 2:1-10 back to God).

Confess areas where you have resisted God's mercy and refused to show mercy to another person.

Ask God to use your mercy to reveal his mercy.
