Sermon: Our Greatest Treasures Scripture: Matthew 6:19-24

OBSERVATION -- As a group, talk through and summarize the passage. Think through *Who, What, Where, When, How, Why* questions together.

INTERPRETATION -- Answer these questions together:

1) What does this passage teach us about God?

- a) Think about verse 24. What does this verse tell us about God and our relationship to him?
- b) Read Psalm 86:9 together. What does this verse tell us about the ultimate goal of disciple-making.

2) What does this passage teach us about us?

- a) Jesus contrasts earthly treasures with heavenly treasures. What are some of your earthly treasures? What are some examples of your heavenly treasures?
- b) What are ways that you are storing treasure on earth? What are ways that you are storing treasure in heaven?

3) What does this passage teach us about grace/salvation? How does it point to Christ? a) Joe Towfighi made a strong point that one of our heavenly treasures are the people that we share the gospel with and disciple (see 1 Thess. 2:19-20; Phil. 4:1). Do you see people this way? Why or why not?

APPLICATION

a) How can you spend your earthly treasures on others so that they might become heavenly treasures? Be specific. Think about your resources, money, possessions, time.

FIGHTER VERSES: Matthew 28:18-20.

PRAYER

- Praise God for those who have disciple you, storing your life in heaven.
- Repent of anything that has become a greater treasure to you than Christ and the gospel
- Ask God to help to store up treasures in heaven.
